Materials List for Uncial Calligraphy

Required materials

- * ink: either walnut or Higgins Eternal Black.
- * **nibs** (remember to buy left-handed nibs if you are left-handed):
 - one or more **Speedball C-2** nibs (Brause 3 mm and Mitchell 1 are also fine)
 - one or more **Speedball C-3** nibs (Brause 2 mm will also work)
- * **nib holder** of your choice
- * 1/2" flat brush: Winsor & Newton series 995, Raphael Kaerell series 8796, or Silver Crystal 6808S
- * 1/4" flat brush: same brands/series
- * practice paper for pen: either Capitol Bond, letter size or 11 x 17", one pack of 50 sheets (only available at johnnealbooks.com) or Canson Pro Layout Marker pad (available locally). *Do not* buy generic "Bond Paper" at Columbia.
- * **practice paper for brush:** I recommend an 18 x 24" pad of newsprint. Any 18 x 24" pad of paper will work though.
- * **fine art paper:** directions will be given for a final project later during the term.
- pencil for ruling lines
- * something to take **notes** in/with and a **folder** for handouts
- * **T-square**, preferably metal and at least 24" long, but bring what you have if you already have one
- * one or more tubes of **gouache**: Winsor & Newton is a good brand
- * old brush for mixing gouache
- small container for water
- * flat **plastic lid**
- * **old toothbrush** for cleaning nibs
- * paper clips, scissors, cotton rag or paper towels, eraser

Optional materials

- * metal cork-backed ruler, at least 24" long (preferred), or any ruler you have
- * eyedropper
- * painter's **tape** or masking tape, low stickiness

Local vendors such as Columbia Art and Drafting, Artist and Craftsman Supply, Blick, and Michael's have most of the needed materials.
